


- Bronze plate - 16 gauge with black filled lettering engraved on it.


SIZE: 6" W x 10" H

Re-elm America By Planting Disease-Resistant Liberty Elms

Dutch elm disease (DED) wiped out over 100,000,000 American elms across the nation between 1945 and 1975, Elm Research Institute was founded in 1967 to develop a truly disease-resistant American elm. In 1985, after extensive genetic engineering and field testing, ERI introduced the American Liberty Elm which has proven to be spectacularly resistant. Over 300,000 planted with less than 3% reported loss to DED.

PUBLIC LIBERTY TREE MEMORIAL
