Mayflower Compact - Nov. 11, 1620
"America's First Constitution"

In the name of God, Amen. We...do by these presents, solemnly and mutually, in the presence of God, and one another; covenant and combine ourselves together into a civil body politic, for our...preservation and furtherance of the ends aforesaid;...to enact, constitute, and frame, such just and equal laws, ordinances, acts, constitutions, and offices...as shall be thought most meet and convenient for the general good of the colony; unto which we promise all due submission and obedience.
